


# HOLLOW EARTH EXPEDITIONS DIMETRODON PACK

This is an Unofficial supplement to the world of *Hollow Earth Expeditions* and the Ubiquity system.

**Field Notes** are short, one shot encounters or introductions to creatures, places and things found throughout the world (both out and within). They are small and lack "area" details so that they may be dropped into an existing campaign without great effort. Enjoy.

## Day 13

This beach is not safe anymore. After several days of dealing with these small, chicken sized lizards constantly harassing us, we have now come upon a greater threat. Dinosaurs.

As incredible as it sounds, we have been beset by Dinosaurs. Today, a large creature that looked remarkably like a Dimetrodon walked past our camp. It seemed unconcerned with us and joined a pack of five smaller ones on the edge of the tree line.

I can only conclude that it was a Bull and the others, his herd of females. He was about 13 feet long, and about 7 feet at the top of his "sail" fin. The females were 8 feet long, with 4 foot high fins.

we watched for several minutes, with guns at the ready, as the Bull just circled his herd. Then, suddenly, the females dashed into the shoreline jungle. For a few moments there was snarling and the sounds of a terrible battle, all the while the Bull just standing there, paying us no mind.

After a moment, a large creature, similar to a surface rhino, burst onto the beach, the females in pursuit. Bleeding from massive bites, it slowly succumb to the vicious attacks of the females.

We watched in horror and amazement as the battle progressed. Then, as the beast started to slump to it's knees, it's ability to

fight weakening, two of the females turned toward us and charged.

Our crew still at the ready with rifle, we opened fire. One of the creatures stopped moving almost immediately, while the other, in it's blood lust charge, made it to our ranks and took the leg from one of the ships crewmen, I believe his name was Smith. We continued to fire on that one and, before it could strike again, it dropped from the wounds.

We again watched the battle with the giant rhino, as it came to it's bloody end. This time, our rifles were trained on the beasts, ready to fire. As the rhino stopped, the three remaining females looked toward us, but did not move. Then, rather suddenly, the Bull rushed the rhino corpse and began feeding. The females then circled a moment and started feeding on the edges.

The whole scene was amazing, like a pride of lions feeding. I could have watched for days, but in safety it was advised that we pack up and make for the jungle. This is a large island and there has got to be some civilization somewhere.



## Dimetrodon

These brutal hunters range in size from the smaller 8 foot females to the larger 14 foot males. They are fast sprinters with sharp, spear like teeth. They live in a "pride" structure, with the females doing all the hunting and killing. The males seem to spend their time fighting the larger beasts to protect their prides, or attacking other bulls to take females from their prides.

Small creatures, such as men, do not appear to be seen as a threat to the Bulls, but to the females, any creature near one of their kills is a potential threat.

As long as you stay clear of the females, Dimetrodon encounters should be able to be avoided without combat. However the low intelligence makes the motivations of these beasts questionable at best.
